Selection trials were also conducted on 7, 8 & 9 Feb. 2020 at C H Muhammed Koya Stadium, Calicut University to finalise the State team for the 18<sup>th</sup> Federation Cup National Junior Athletics Championship scheduled at Bhopal from 6 to 8 April 2020. Unfortunately due to the outspread of Corona virus, the meet cancelled.

#### VI. Kids' Athletics

Kids' Athletics State Committee meeting held twice this year. Kerala State Athletics Association has conducted one day workshop on 'Kids' Athletics' on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2019 at VKN Menon Indoor Stadium, Thrissur. The workshop conducted for all district representatives to educate about Kids' Athletics programme. Kerala State Athletics Association Secretary **Prof.Babu.P.I** has presided over the inaugural ceremony and Thrissur District Sports Council president **Sri.K R Sambashivan** inaugurated the same. Around 50 members participated in programme.

Most of the Districts completed the District level competitions and the Kids' Athletics Committee has decided to conduct the state level Kids Athletics championship in the month of February 2020. Due to the unavailability of an Indoor stadium and the oncoming annual examinations of students the competitions were postponed to first week of April 2020. And now it is indefinitely postponed due to the outspread of Covid 19 Virus.

#### VII. Federation Technical Officials (FTO) Examination

On behalf of Athletics Federation of India, Kerala State Athletics Association organized the FTO seminar and examination 2019 at Government College of Physical Education East Hill, Calicut, Kerala state on 6,7 & 8 September 2019.

65 candidates including 15 female candidates appeared for the seminar and examination out of which 38 candidates passed.

## **ACTIVITIES**

### **36<sup>th</sup> Sub Junior and 46<sup>th</sup> Junior Kerala State Aquatic Championship 2019**

The Kerala State Sub Junior and Junior Aquatic Championship was held at Aquatic Complex, Pirappancode, Thiruvananthapuram from 24<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> May 2019.

The Championship was held in the following age group in Swimming and water polo for Boys and Girls in accordance with FINA and SFI Rules.

Altogether 629 number of Swimmers/Waterpolo players participated in the Championship representing 14 Districts. 30 technical Officials assisted the conduct of this state Championship. **25 New State records** were created during the state championships. The Championship was held in the following age group in Swimming and waterpolo for Boys and Girls in accordance with FINA & SFI Rules. All the participants and Officials were provided with comfortable boarding and lodging for three days. Sri.S.Rajiv, Vice President, Swimming Federation of India was the Chief Guest for the closing ceremony.

### **36<sup>th</sup>Sub Junior National Aquatic Championship-2019- Rajkot 26<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> June2019**

The Kerala State Sub Junior team was selected from the performance in the Kerala State Sub Junior and Junior Aquatic Championship held at Aquatic Complex, Pirappancode. The State team Coaching Camp prior to National participation was held at Aquatic Complex Pirappancode from 1<sup>st</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> June 2019. Six Swimmers were selected to the State Team, out of which only 2 girls attended the camp rest of them undergone training under their personal

coaches. All the campers including, Coach and Managers were provided with comfortable boarding and lodging in the Camp. State team was provided with comfortable berth during their travel to Rajkot. The State team Coaching Camp prior to National participation was held at Aquatic Complex, Pirappancode. 46 participants attended the coaching camp and finally 25 Boys and 26 girls selected to the State Team based on the Coaching Camp performance. All the participants, Coach and Managers were provided with comfortable boarding and lodging at the Camp. After completion of the camp the State team proceeded to Rajkot on 23<sup>rd</sup> June and returned on 3<sup>rd</sup> July. The 67<sup>th</sup> Kerala State Aquatic Championship for Men and Women was held at Aquatic Complex, Thrissur on 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup> July 2019. Competitions were held for Men and Women sections in Swimming and Waterpolo, in accordance with FINA and SFI Rules.

- Minimum Age Limit: 25 years and above.
- Age determining date: The actual age of the competitor as at 31<sup>st</sup> December 2019.
- Age Groups: Individual events-25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80 and above. Relay events: based on total age of the team members in whole years. 100- 119, 120-159, 160-199, 200-239, 240-279, 280-310, 320-359.

All together 138 swimmers participated in the championship representing 11 Districts. ### **State Coaching Camps & National Participations**

Archery Association of India planned to conduct all Nationals by the end of March & mid April. As the Covid 19 situation hit India badly and we had a lock down, none of the nationals happened for the year 2019-20, so there were no State Coaching camps either.

## **4. Kerala Badminton (Shuttle) Association**

The year 2019 has been a milestone year and it has seen KBSA perform exceedingly well by way of providing improved facilities to players, improved standards in conduct and organisation of tournaments, quality of technical officials and greater support and financial help to district units.

The year end, has seen the whole world been shaken up by the pandemic Covid 19 and like all other fields, it has derailed sporting activity too. Many tournaments at National and International levels have either been cancelled or postponed. Players have been unable to practise on court and were depended on exercises to keep themselves physically fit. We sure shall overcome this temporary setback and normalcy will prevail.

- **Conduct of tournaments.** We started our tournament activities in April 2019 with the All India Senior ranking tournament and ended our programme with the Veteran State championships in January 2020. Over this period 15 tournaments (9 state level ranking prize money tournaments, 4 Kerala State Championship & 2 All India Ranking tournaments) were held in the most professional and efficient manner to the satisfaction of all participants.

A first of its kind, The Mathrubhumi All Kerala Inter School Championship 2019 was held during Nov – Dec 2019 unifying the ICSE, CBSE and State Syllabus Schools. The inter school tournament witnessed

massive participation with 30 plus schools participating in each of the district level competition. The state finals were played amongst the best two schools from each of the 14 districts and two promising players were selected and send to Indonesia for a month-long training at world renowned Badminton academy. All expenses including travel, accommodation and coaching fee was taken care by the Sponsor /Association.

- **Conduct of Coaching camps.** As part of state team preparation, coaching camps were organised for all state teams under coaches Shri Joy T Antony, Shri Renosh James, Shri T Abhilash and Shri A Nazer. District level coaching camps are also being conducted at all 14 Districts.
- **Air Travel / AC Train travel for players.** KBSA gives top priority to player facilities and we are happy to say that our Sub Junior State team travelled by Air and the other state teams travelled by AC Train to participate in National / Zonal Championships 2019.
- **Player Kitting.** Kerala state players were provided in addition to tracksuits from Kerala Sports council, Yonex brand T shirts (minimum two), Yonex badminton shoes and Yonex track suits. Each player was provided kit worth minimum of Rs 10,000/- each.
- **Cash Incentive and Grants to District Associations.** An amount of Rs 50,000/- was presented to Shri Kiran George for his medal winning performance at National Championships. All the 14 District Associations were provided with financial grant of Rs 10,000/- each in addition to Yonex Shuttles worth Rs 25,000/- for developmental activities. Additional grants were provided to those Districts that conducted Ranking / State / National tournaments.
- **Transparency in Draws of state championships.** We have been the first state in the country to conduct live draws in front of the participants before start of all the Kerala State Championships 2019. Technical innovations introduced by KBSA like live scoring, online entry system, online certificate generation and player ranking system has ensured transparency in our activities and has been appreciated by the parents and players.
- **Meetings.** Regular conduct of meetings and full participation by all members in the discussions has been the strength of our Association.
- **District level activities.** All the 14 District units of KBSA were very active in the promotion of the game. Coaching camps and tournaments were being held regularly held. The number of indoor badminton courts has increased dramatically and has been a supplement for the growth. We roughly estimate that there are around (Indoor wooden flooring hall) 500 venues with 3 courts or less and around 30 venues with 4 or more courts. It is steadily increasing

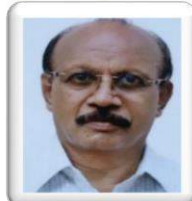

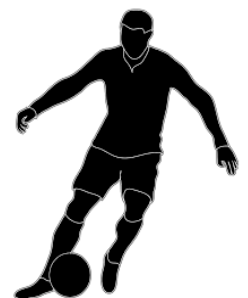

KPL 2019-2020 was organized in two phases, phase 1 of the league was organized from 15<sup>th</sup> Dec 2019 to 15<sup>th</sup> Jan 2020. Phase 2 was kept on hold till we received a confirmation on the final round matches of Santosh trophy 2019-20 from AIFF which were scheduled to be organized in the last week of Jan 2020 at Aizwal, Mizoram. Since the initial dates of the final round got postponed due to unforeseen circumstances, Phase 2 of KPL 2019-20 was organized from 18<sup>th</sup> Jan 2020 onwards.

One of the participating teams, Kannur FC withdrew from the league without offering any genuine reason which affected the league negatively also

inconveniencing those teams who had finished playing their matches with Kannur FC as all results of Kannur FC had to be declared null and void. The unethical and unprofessional behavior displayed by the club officials of Kannur FC and their violation of the KPL league regulations after having submitted an undertaking to follow the same was brought before the KPL disciplinary committee. After proper scrutiny, the KPL disciplinary committee recommended to desist the membership of the club by imposing a fine of INR 25,000/-. The matter was then placed before the Kerala FA Executive Committee for approval. The decision of the Ex-Co to desist the membership of Kannur FC was communicated to the club as a result of which the club has been placed under 'inactive' status but the club is yet to pay the fine imposed on them.

The matches were organized across seven venues namely Ambedkar Stadium in Ernakulam, KSSC Stadium, Panampally Nagar in Ernakulam, Rajeev Gandhi Stadium in Kasaragod, Corporation Stadium in Thrissur, Kottapady Maidan Stadium in Malappuram, Rajeev Gandhi Stadium in Tirur and EMS Stadium in Kozhikode.

### **Semi-Final Matches:**

1<sup>st</sup> Semi-final was played between SAT Tirur and Kerala Blasters FC at Rajeev Gandhi Stadium, Tirur.

2<sup>nd</sup> Semi-final was played between Gokulam Kerala FC and Kerala Police F C at EMS Stadium, Kozhikode.
